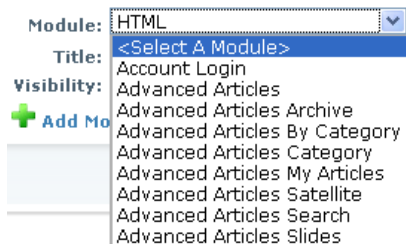

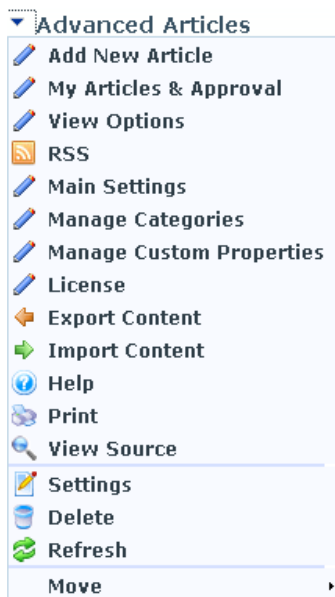

Advanced Articles module options give much flexibility for user. User can change many options on adding, editing, displaying the articles.

### **1.1 Add New Article/ Edit Article**

User can use “Add New Article” button or choose from the module option. Follow the on-screen instruction to enter the article details, and then click the Publish button at the bottom. However, “Submit For Approval” button will be shown for submit role user account instead of “Publish” button in admin account.

You can choose to “Save As Draft” as well, draft articles are not displayed to the public or in the “Show not approved articles” list.

After submitting the article, submit role user has to wait for approval and will see the article title with yellow color. The submitted user can still edit if there is something to change. The article submitted will not be displayed unless approval.

Once the user edits their articles, the article will not be displayed until admin approves.

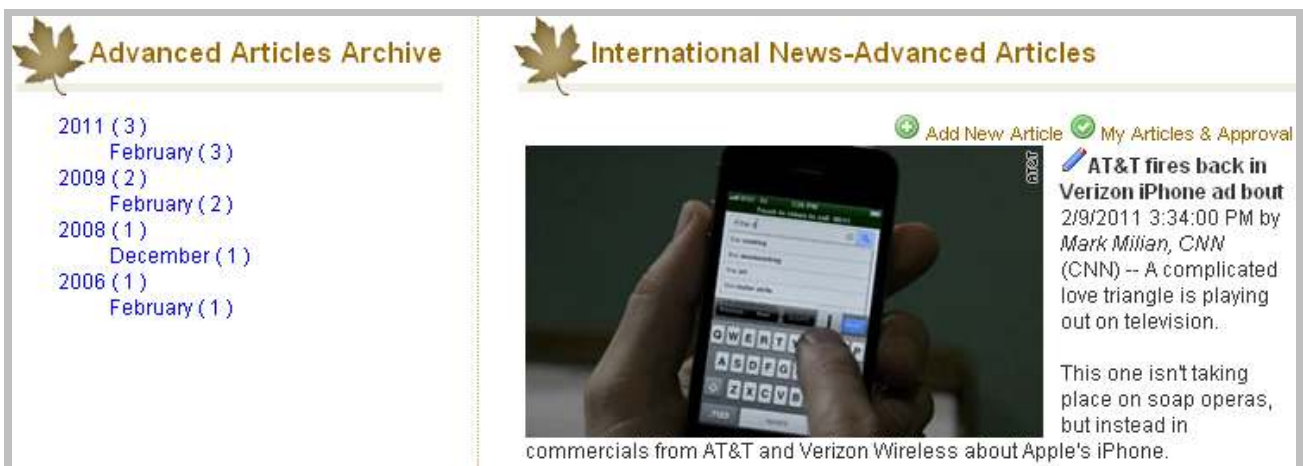

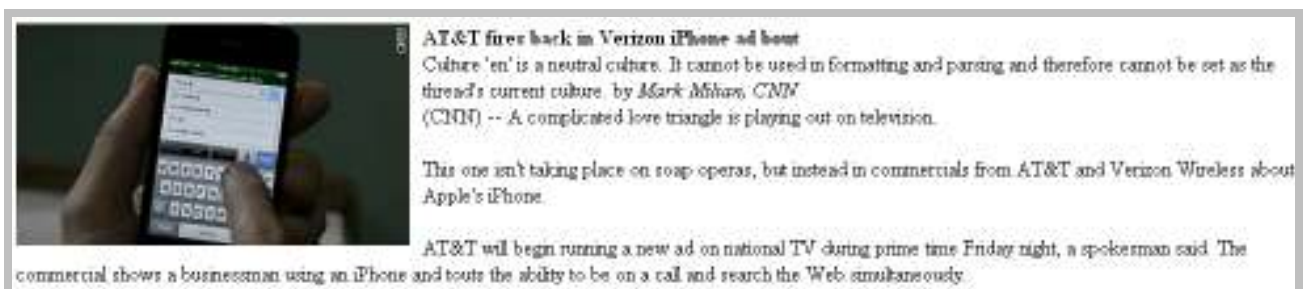
**1. Inline with page content using [DETAILINLINE] token**

This is to display content at the same position as the original Advanced Articles module, as shown below. If there are other modules on the page, those other modules will be displayed as well.



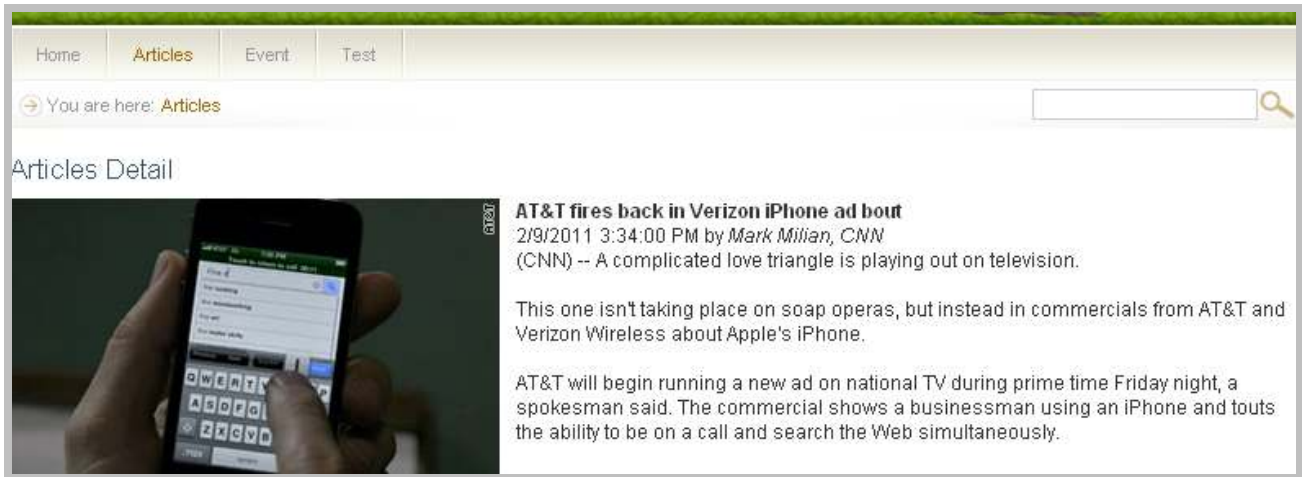
**2. In a pop up display using [DETAILPOPUP] token**

This is to display article details in a new tab without DNN skin, as shown below: Only article content will be displayed.



**3. In a separate page without other page content using [DETAIL] token**

This shall render the article content using the DNN skin, and ONLY the article detail will be displayed. If there are other modules on the page, those other modules will NOT be displayed.

**Apple poised to make 'universal' iPhone, says analyst**  
 23 hours ago by *SuperUser Account*  
 Apple has the pieces needed to build an iPhone model that can connect to just about any cellular network.

The evidence was found under the hood of a new iPhone 4 unit made for Verizon Wireless.

To work with the nonstandard infrastructure used by Verizon, Apple needed to deploy a different cell chip. The hardware company had to alter parts of the iPhone's construction in order to make it compatible, Apple COO Tim Cook said during the phone's coming-out event.

While the new iPhone will only work on Verizon's network, the Qualcomm chip Apple is using in these new models is capable of connecting to Verizon's network, as well as to carriers using the GSM standard, which is what AT&T and T-Mobile USA have.

The finding was unearthed by repair firm iFixIt in a full dissection of a Verizon iPhone obtained through the pre-order system.

## Annex A: Tokens Replace Reference

This module supports token replace class. This is very powerful because users are able to completely customize their own different view from the available data.

Token Replace allows the following notations:

- [Object :Property]
- [Object :Property|Format]
- [Object :Property|Format|IfEmptyReplacement]

The output can be formatted using a format string. You can use the usual Date and Time Format Strings for date values or Numeric Format Strings for any numeric value. String values are handled using String.Format.

Example:

[User:Lastname Dear Mr./Mrs . {0}]	will render:	Dear Mr./Mrs. Walker
[Date:Now dddd]	will render:	Monday
[Date:Now MM/dd/yyyy]	will render:	09/22/2008

<b>[EDIT]</b>	This will render an edit pencil, if, and only if, the logged on user had edit rights for the module. You MUST add this token to the Item Template (and alternate item template if you are using that), in order to be able to edit items
<b>[ITEMID]</b>	This will render the item id of the article.
<b>[MODULEID]</b>	This will render the module id of the module the event belongs to
<b>[TABID]</b>	This will render the tab id of the module the article belongs to
<b>[CREATEDBYUSER]</b>	This will display the display the user id that created the event.
<b>[CREATEDDATE]</b>	This will show the item creation date, in localized long date format. You can format the date to your desired layout.
<b>[SUMMARY]</b> <b>[SUMMARY 999]</b>	This will render the summary of article. The length of the summary to be rendered can be defined using format provider. <b>[EXPIRYTIME]</b>	This will render the article time, in localized long time format. You can format the time value to your desired layout.
<b>[STATUS]</b>	This will render the article's current status, such as Draft, Published, Expired.
<b>[FEATURED]</b>	This will render whether the article is featured or not.
<b>[AUTHOR]</b>	This will render the article's author.
<b>[READMORE]</b>	This will render the hyper link to the attachment of the article.
<b>[READMORELINK]</b>	This will render the raw hyper link to the attachment of the article.
<b>[DETAILLINK]</b>	This will render the raw hyper link to the detail page of the article with DNN skin and other modules
<b>[DETAILINLINE]</b>	This will render the raw hyper link to the detail page of the article with DNN skin and other modules
<b>[DETAIL]</b>	This will render the raw hyper link to the detail page of the article with skin but will not display other modules.

<b>[DETAILPOPOP]</b>	This will render the raw hyper link to the detail page of the article in a new separate tab without skin.	
<b>[IMAGE]</b>	This will render the image attached to the article. There are more ways to use this:	
	<b>[IMAGE]</b>	This will render the complete image tag.
	<b>[IMAGE width,]</b> e.g. <b>[IMAGE 100,]</b>	This will render the image displayed in the width specified. This is useful when you want to force the image to be displayed at a particular width, where user may upload images at various sizes.
	<b>[IMAGE width, height]</b> e.g. <b>[IMAGE 100,80]</b>	This will render the image displayed in the width, height specified.
<b>[IMAGESOURCE]</b>	This will render the raw image path attached to the article.	
<b>[NEWARTICLEFLAG]</b>	This will render the  flag, if the article is published within 7 (by default) days.	
	<b>[NEWARTICLEFLAG days as new]</b> e.g. <b>[NEWARTICLEFLAG 5]</b>	This will override the default 7 days. If an article is published within 5 (the days specified) days, a flag is displayed.
<b>[FRIENDLYPUBLISHDATE]</b>	This is similar to the token <b>[PUBLISHDATE]</b> , except for recently published articles (up to 5 days ago), it will display in a friendly format such as: 4 days ago, 13 hours ago, 35 minutes ago. If the publish date is more than 5 days ago, it will display the same content as the <b>[PUBLISHDATE]</b> token. You can apply custom formatting to this token.
